

COURT ALLOCATIONS

On Mondays, we are trialling our previously used system for allocating games to courts to try to ensure everyone gets their fair share of games.

From 7:45pm to 8:45pm, the system will apply to the four courts not being used for A/B team match practice and from 8:45pm to 9:45pm, to all six courts.

On arrival (or when a player is finished at the A/B match practice), each player should add their name to the bottom of the list of players on the white board.

When a court is free, the player at the top of the list can either:

- Choose four players (including him or herself) from the first six players listed to play a game on the available court OR;
- Choose not to play and let the next listed player choose four players (including him or herself) from the six players listed starting with him/herself. The player choosing not to play would remain top of the list and have first refusal when the next court becomes available.

Immediately prior to a new game starting, the four players about to play should score their names off the list.

When a game finishes, the four players from the game should add their names to the bottom of the list. A player wishing to rest may choose to delay adding his/her name but names should always be added to the end of the list.

The idea is that whilst a player can choose not to go on and wait to play with others, the choosing player can not skip over everyone who has been waiting the longest to go on.

Examples

When a court becomes free and Noah chooses to play, he can choose three of Amelia, Theo, Isla, Oliver, and Freya to join him in a game.	When a court becomes free and Lily chooses <u>not</u> to play, Leo can choose three of Florence, Freddie, Willow, Arthur, and Rosie to join him in a game. Lily will then have the option to form a game when the next court is free.
