The volunteers, coaches, young people, and players at Glenearn Badminton Club (“the Club”) should help to make badminton safe and fun.

Our Code of Conduct for adult players is as follows:

- Treat everyone fairly and equally regardless of their age, gender, race, disability, sexual orientation, background, or circumstances.
- Respect the spirit of fair play in badminton. This is more than simply playing within the rules. It also incorporates the concepts of friendship, respect for others and always participating with the right spirit.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others.
- Conduct yourself in a manner that takes all reasonable measures to protect your own safety and the safety of others.
- Promote the reputation of the Club and the sport of badminton, taking all reasonable steps to prevent them from being brought into disrepute.
- Protect yourself and others involved in the game from verbal or physical abuse and threatening or intimidating behaviour.
- Abide by the Club’s and Badminton Scotland’s policies, including the Club’s online safety and social media policy.
- Take personal responsibility to ensure that you are suitably insured for your activities by, for example, affiliating as a member of Badminton Scotland.

Breaches of this code may result in action being taken by the Club.
